APPLICATION

PROPERTIES

Application temperature range: +5°C to +40°C

Shelf life: 24 months when stored flat in original packaging in cool, dry conditions.

INSTRUCTIONS

Surface preparation: All surfaces should be clean, dry and free from frost, grease and loose materials. When cleaning contaminated substrates, HS Butyl recommend that propan-2-ol (IPA) is used and allowed to dry prior to the application of the tape. Do not use white spirit or household cleaners, as these can leave a residue that will prevent the bath trim bonding to the wall or bath or worktop.

Application: Cut a strip long enough for the joint to be sealed. Fold the tape along the hinge. If there are to be joins at wall corners, cut a triangle off the horizontal piece, at an angle of 45° at the end where the join is to go. Remove the release film in short lengths and apply the tape to the joint, ensuring that the hinge is placed right into the back of the joint, so that when the vertical and horizontal sides bond to their respective surfaces, they lie flat against them. If this is not achieved, then the tape may not bond well to one or both surfaces. Once in place, press the tape down hard along its length in order to ensure good adhesion along the whole length.

PACKAGING

The product is normally supplied as individually packed rolls in a clampack. Roll length and packaging specifications should be agreed prior to purchase. Available colours: The Bath Trim is normally white, but ivory is available in some widths. Other colours by arrangement. The butyl colour is white.
